DART service change scheduled for Sunday, Feb. 19

Beginning Sunday, Feb. 19, 2017, the following changes will be made to better serve DART riders.

- Local Route 5 (Franklin Avenue) will be permanently adjusted to run on Woodland Avenue from 10th Street to Martin Luther King Jr Parkway to better serve Methodist Hospital and Sherman Hill. It will no longer serve High Street and Ingersoll Avenue between 10th Street and Martin Luther King Jr Parkway. Local Route 5 will detour on Grand Avenue/Locust Street and will not run on High Street between 6th and 10th Streets until construction is completed either later this year or early next year.
- Minor time adjustments on Local Routes 4, 5, 6, 13, 14, 16 and 17
- A downtown timepoint and bus stop located at 3rd and Locust has moved to 4th and Locust for Express Routes 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, 96, and 99.

New schedules are available on ridedart.com. Printed schedules are available on DART buses and at DART Central Station. The next scheduled service change is June 2017.
