DART to donate vans to local nonprofits

Applications due March 31, 2021

Local nonprofit organizations, community groups or government agencies within DART's service area are invited to apply to receive a retired RideShare van. The DART Commission created the annual van donation program in 2014 to assist agencies in providing transportation to those who may not have access to public transportation. Applications for this year's donation cycle are due on Wednesday, March 31.
