

The route will travel to the Amazon facility from DART Central Station twice daily (including weekends). The route will also travel from the Amazon facility to DART Central Station three times on weekdays and twice on weekends. Schedule changes: Local Route 4 and Express Route 98

DART is making changes to schedules for Local Route 4 to better fit commute times for riders using this service. As a result, the first bus leaving downtown traveling to Ankeny will be Local Route 4, leaving from DART Central Station at 5:25 a.m. Previously the first bus leaving downtown to Ankeny was a Route 98 bus that riders would board at 5:57 a.m. at Locust and 7th.
